<b>Position:</b>	Support Worker (Including Relief Support Worker)
<b>Closing Date:</b>	<b>Monday 19<sup>th</sup> June 2023</b>
<b>Salary:</b>	£24,368.53 p.a. pro rata (£11.53 ph) – Unqualified (based on a 39 hour working week). £25,243.92 p.a. pro rata (£11.95 ph) – Qualified (based on a 39 hour working week). £11.97 per hour for Relief.
<b>Hours of work:</b>	Full time, part-time and relief hours available up to 39 hours per week to be worked on a rota basis including evenings and weekends.
<b>Place of work:</b>	<b>Edinburgh Housing Services</b> – Granton, Leith, Milton Road, Corstorphine, Morningside and Slateford  <b>Edinburgh Outreach Services</b>
<b>Probationary period:</b>	Six months
